Cyber Chip Helpful Pointers

REQUIREMENTS

Grades 6-8 and Grades 9-12 go to the following page and click your grade group and do each step (these are the requirements for your age group):

CyberChip Requirement #3 (Grades 6-8) or #4 (Grades 9-12). I would like to suggest that the entire MB group put together a skit that will be presented to the troop at a future scout meeting. Since we have folks from both middle and high schools we will combine these requirements.

We need a leader or two to take charge of putting together a skit (which I will review first) and to put on the skit at a meeting. The skit should include the EDGE method and must include everything in "The Scout Law and Cybersafety/Cyberbullying" signature document (see below).

If everyone will be present at the next campout, the skit can be done there but will probably be in addition to any patrol skit.
